- **assessment of impact thinking and impact planning in projects**

A. Impact Potential

- To what extent is it described and specified which long-term local development the project will achieve and what scope (dissemination) it want to achieve?

B. Impact Objective

- To what extent are there SMARTa impact objectives some years after the project (not performance targets at the end of the project)? Specific, Measurable, Accepted, Realistic and Time Bound.

C. Impact Path

- To what extent is a realistic and comprehensive plan for how valuable results should be transferred and converted into long-term impact?

D. Impact Organization

- To what extent is there an organization for effects with a clear and committed project owner (who is not also project manager) and involved beneficiary organizations that can take over the results?

E. Impact Financing

- To what extent is there an idea and (business) plan for how the results can be financed in the long term after the project?
